0. APPLICATION/ FARES/ EXPENSES

A. Application:

First/Business RT/CT/OJ via QF/BA via EH (not via Africa), AP, TS Travel via a ticketed point in Europe to which these fares are not published is not permitted. Capacity limitations apply.

B. Fares: Effective for sales/travel from 01 November 2005

- C. Passenger Expenses: not permitted

4. FLIGHT APPLICATION

- A. Valid QF/BA/AA/EI/AO/BD only
- B. Valid on BD between LON and BFS
- C. Valid on EI between LON/PAR/FRA and Ireland only
- D. Valid on AA services within North America except to/from Hawaii
- E. Travel via Africa is not permitted
- F. Within UK/Europe: Maximum 2 European sectors permitted, one in each direction.

G. Within North America: One sector permitted on QF/AA services in each direction and must be in a continuous forward direction, without backtracking. Travel is not permitted on AA codeshare flights with numbers AA6000-7999.

H. Travel is not permitted on AA flights to/from Honolulu (HNL).

I. Travel is not permitted on the following BA codeshare flights: BA4301-4309, BA7150-7151, BA7272-7233, BA5000-BA5699. All other BA codeshare services permitted when operated by oneworld carriers.

J. QF code-shares are permitted when 'operated' by oneworld carriers (subject to routing conditions). Travel is not permitted on the following flights: QF323-24, QF353-54, QF363-66, QF375-78, QF391/93, QF395-98, QF3019-20, QF3025-26, QF3090-93, QF3323-24, QF3343-46, QF305-318/QF3700-3771/QF3784-3799/QF5000-QF5999.

Exception: permitted on AS operated codeshare between LAX-YVR

5. RESERVATIONS AND TICKETING

A. Reservations

- 1. Must be made for the entire journey.
- 2. ABED fare: QF/BA/AA: A class

QF/BA:	D class (if A not available, book D class)
QF:	Y class (Domestic New Zealand)
EI:	D class (if D not available, book Y)
AO:	H class
QF/BA:	D/C class (intra Europe)
BD:	V class
DBED fare: QF/BA:	D class
QF/BA:	B class (if D not available, book B class)
QF:	Y class (Domestic New Zealand)
AA:	D class (if D not available, book A or Y)
EI:	D class (if D not available, book Y)
AO:	H class
BD:	V class

H class on AO sectors is economy class travel with no compensation

3. If no first class is offered, passengers may book in D class without compensation.

B. Payment and ticketing:

Deadline : For bookings made:

4 days or more before departure – ticketing time limit 3 days prior to departure Between 3 days and 1 day before departure – ticketing time limit 1 day prior to departure.

Bookings made on the day of departure should be ticketed as soon as possible.

7. MAXIMUM STAY: 12 months

- 8. **STOPOVERS:** Two permitted in each direction at transfer points. Note:
 - 1. Only 1 stopover in Australia in each direction when travel is via the EH.
 - 2. No stopover permitted in AKL when travel originates from WLG/CHC/ZQN for travel via EH/AP.

9. TRANSFERS

- 1. 1 transfer permitted at LON/PAR/FRA/ROM in each direction
- 2. 1 transfer permitted at SYD/MEL/BNE in each direction via EH only
- 3. 1 transfer permitted at SIN/BKK/HKG/TYO in each direction
- 4. 2 transfers permitted in Area 1 in each direction for travel via the AP
- 5. Additional transfers:
 - i. 1 transfer permitted at AKL in each direction between QF and QF/BA for travel originating WLG/CHC for travel via the EH/AP.
 - ii. 1 transfer permitted at PER/CNS in each direction via the EH
 - iii. 1 transfer permitted at MAN in each direction for travel via the AP
- 4. Surface sectors permitted

10. CONSTRUCTION AND COMBINATIONS

- A. Constructions: Constructions with addons not permitted.
- B. Combinations:
 - 1. End on combinations permitted with domestic fares and Oneworld Visit Europe fare (rule D005).
 - 2. One way travel at half the RT fare is not permitted.
 - 3. One half of this fare may be combined with one half of the equivalent BA fare (rule ???) to form a round trip or open jaw journey.

15. SALES RESTRICTIONS, EXTENSION OF VALIDITY

A. Advertising and sales.

- 1. Sales/travel from 01November2005
- 2. Ticket stock: QF/BA only
- 3. Sales restricted to New Zealand only
- B. Extension of ticket validity: permitted only in the event of illness of passenger or certified death of an immediate family member/accompanying passenger. See PAT General Rule 13.2.13 for full requirements.

16. CHANGES AND REFUNDS

A. Voluntary rebooking and rerouting:

- 1. Revalidation permitted
- 2. Changes requiring ticket reissue at NZD 100 per transaction.

B. Involuntary rebooking and rerouting: permitted only in the event of certified death of an immediate family member/accompanying passenger/immediate family member but only as provided in PAT General Rule 13.2.11.4.

C. Cancellation/no-show/upgrading

- 1. Before departure: Cancellation/no show: forfeit NZD200 per adult and NZD150 per child. 10pct cancellation fee applicable to infants.
- 2. After departure: refund if any will be the difference between the fare paid and the applicable fare for the journey completed less the applicable penalty.
- 3. At any time this fare may be used as credit towards payment of a higher fare provided conditions of that fare have been met.

17. HIP/Mileage/Other Construction Exceptions

- A. Mileage surcharges up to 10M may be ignored.
- B. HIP points may be ignored.
- C. Except as may be otherwise provided in 4(Flight Application), IATA fare constructions apply.

18. Ticket entries and endorsements

- 1. Fare basis: ABED/DBED
- 2. Endorsements: Valid on QF/BA/AA/EI/AO.
- 3. Fare calculation: show fares used in combination separately.

19. Children and Infant discounts

- A. Children: 2-11 years charge 75pct of the applicable adult fare.
- B. Infants: charge 10pct of the applicable adult fare
- If occupying a seat charge 75pct of the applicable adult fare.
- C. Unaccompanied children/infants not permitted.
- C. For general conditions applicable see Definitions and Explanations and General Rule 6.2.
- 20. Tour Conductor discounts: not permitted
- 21. Agents discounts: not permitted.
