EXCEPTION 1: The service charge will not apply if the ticket is exchanged for a higher fare ticket with the same origin/destination.

EXCEPTION 2: The service charge will not apply provided the changes are made at least 30 days before the new flight and there is no change to the origin/destination.

(M) CANCELLATION AND REFUNDS

(1) Prior to Departure

In the event of cancellation or failure to use reservation, the non-refundable amount will be the fare paid less 25 percent.

(2) After Departure

The refund, if any, will be the difference between the fare paid and the applicable fare for the transportation used less 25 percent.

(3) At any time, a full refund will apply in the event of the death or illness of the passenger or a member of his/her immediate family if substantiated by a death/medical certificate.
