

Expectant mothers

Although pregnancy is not considered to be a medical condition, please note bmi conditions of carriage:

- Travel is permitted up to the end of the 36th week for single pregnancies and the end of the 32nd week for multiple births (e.g. twins).
- After the end of the 30th week of pregnancy the expectant mother must carry a certificate from their doctor or midwife confirming the estimated date of delivery and that there are no complications with the pregnancy
- Return journeys must be considered when making the reservation
- Mothers are not recommended to travel within 7 days of giving birth
- New born babies under 7 days old will not be accepted for travel
- Premature and/or unhealthy babies may only be accepted for travel after Medical Clearance and with a qualified escort such as a doctor or state registered nurse.
